

# Amendments to the Beer Guide

Due to unforeseen problems at various breweries, The following beers have been substituted for beers which are unavailable. Enjoy the Festival

**2** **Saltaire; Blonde 4.% abv.** A straw coloured light ale with soft malt flavours, delicately hopped with Czech and German hop varieties

**3** **Robinsons; Pint of Thrones 4.0% abv.** The King in the north arrives in April! Traditional amber ale, full bodied, reliable & down to earth with a warm heart of spicy cedar. Level headed & big hearted that always win's the day

**19** **Bespoke; Fathom it out IPA 4.2% abv** A golden Indian Pale Ale bittered with a spicy Columbus hops with a fruity citrus finish from Citra and Pallisade hops

**24** **Swan Brewery; Swan on the River 4.2% abv.** A pale ale, hopped with Challenger and late hopped with Summit and Calypso. The hops have been selected to deliver light, floral notes, fitting with the feel-good, taste-good summer sensation of this cracking cask ale

**25** **Swan Brewery Swan Gold 4.0% abv.** A golden brew of 4.0% strength making it an anytime ale. saaz provides the mainstay of the hop character. More usually found in classic lagers imparting a delicate floral aroma to the ale.

**33** **Great Western Brewery; GWB Bees Knees 4.2% abv** Don't be fooled by the name, it is not as sweet as it sounds. The Bees Knees boasts a very unique pallet, which is greatly due to a small but significant amount of Mexican Orange Blossom Honey. The Golding hops accompany the orange characteristic given by the honey, making this a bitter with a fruity twist to it.
